Thank you so much for your participation at the sewing party at Mt. Lebanon United Methodist Church on Sunday, September 10, 2017. Because of you and others in attendance, more than 500 Girl Empowerment Pad (GEP) kits were assembled at the party. Added with previously made kits, the total packed for the September 13 shipment to Zimbabwe for 2017 was 1422 to the school complex and 419 to the hospital in Nyadire. In addition, 17 sewing machines were sent this year (14 to schools and three to affiliated clinics).

This impressive achievement would not have been possible without your support. You have made a difference in the lives of girls, who often miss school every month for lack of protection. Your gift will help encourage them to stay in school this year!

On behalf of The Nyadire Connection (TNC) and the GEP program team, please accept our gratitude for your work. And please also help us thank those who came to the sewing party who may not have provided us with an e-mail address.
