

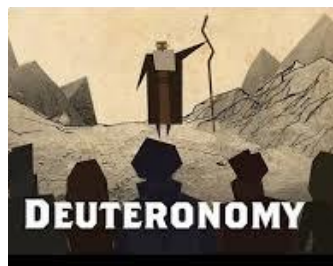

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 14th.

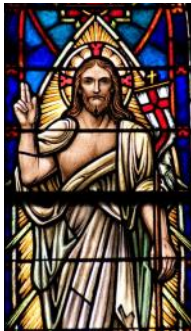
Lent is a time of repentance, fasting and preparation for the coming of Easter. It is a time of self-examination and reflection. (wpaumc.org)

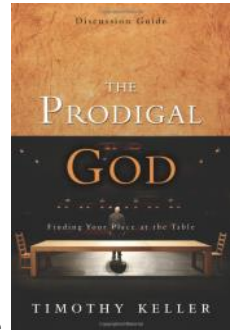
