

Modern Worship @ Mt. Lebanon United Methodist Church Raise your hands for a new alternative worship experience!

Plans are in the making for a new worship service featuring a modern format, a message delivered by Assistant to the Pastor Scott Miller, and today's style of music. The church has scheduled a bit of a preview—on Sunday, August 18, congregation members and friends are invited to the 8:30 service in Sanner Chapel, celebrated with contemporary music and guitar accompaniment.

The new modern service is not meant to be a detraction from the church's traditional service at 10:45, but is proposed to be an alternative experience, a non-traditional worship choice. Though the launch date is not yet set, the weekly service is scheduled for 8:30 AM in Sanner Chapel. This time slot is not perfect, but appears to be the best choice. While 9:30 AM in Asbury Center was considered, the new service at that time would conflict with Faith for Today, strong and well-attended adult Sunday school classes, Scott Miler's confirmation class teaching role and receptions in Asbury Center.
