




Showing Love How My Heart Feels




Using a variety of colors and images, draw inside the heart the different ways you show and feel love. On the lines above and below the heart, write what your pictures represent.

Chicken Soup Mix


Jar Comtents

- 2 cups uncooked egg noodles
- 3 tablespoons dried onion flakes
- 3 tablespoons chicken bouillon granules
- 1 teaspoon dill weed
- 1 teaspoon celery seed
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder

Ingredients Needed

- 14 cups water
- 2½ cups mixed vegetables
- 2 cups cooked chicken

To make soup, bring to a boil 14 cups of water. Add contents of jar, stir, and cover. Reduce heat and simmer for 20 minutes. Then add to pot 2½ cups mixed vegetables and 2 cups cooked chicken. Let simmer for an additional 10 minutes to heat thoroughly.


