

UNICEF

UNICEF was created in 1946 to help children in places where there was fighting in Europe, China, and the Middle East. UNICEF originally stood for United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund. UNICEF USA was officially founded in 1947 to support UNICEF's lifesaving work for children. By 1953, UNICEF changed its name to United Nations Children's Fund and expanded its reach to more countries.

Today, UNICEF works in more than 190 countries and territories to save and improve children's lives. UNICEF promotes the rights and well-being of every child and provides education, food, safety, and protection. UNICEF has helped save more children's lives than any other human rights organization.
