By now you know that my last few hours at Weekday Ministries Childcare Center will be Pre-K graduation, May 26<sup>th</sup>. It has been almost 14 years!

When I began, there were file folders piled around my office; uncashed checks between sheets of paper; holes in the vinyl window shades; coats stacked three high on pegs in the hall; and donated refrigerators and microwaves.

But there were also caring, kind teachers playing games with the children; appreciation from grateful parents; well-prepared kindergartners; before and after school care and summer camp.

We were severely in the red, financially. We made big changes to the program so that we could serve children better and make certain we would not have to close because of lack of funding.

With good financial stewardship, we were able to add wooden cubbies in the hallway; new blinds; carpet; vinyl flooring; cots and cribs; and toys and equipment. And now, our bathrooms are being refurbished and we have a security system!

We have raised tuition judiciously, respecting that childcare is very expensive for families, but without increasing revenue, we would not attract or retain good staff.

Mrs. Beth Brack has been serving Weekday Ministries since 1996. I could not be leaving my position in better hands. She has taught in every room. Most recently, Beth has been the lead teacher in the Sr. Pre-K room. Our reputation for sending kindergartners to area schools well-prepared can be credited to her.

Beth possesses the marks of a fine director. She has spent the past nine months in training with me. The childcare center will continue to serve your family well.

May God richly inspire and guide Beth Brack in her new role as the Director of Weekday Ministries.

May the Lord guide your family as you raise your children. May you know His love and truth.
