Capital Campaign Progress


We are pleased to report that our capital campaign to update the front of our church building is off to a very positive beginning. To date, we have received approximately \$55,000.00 in gifts and pledges toward our goal of \$80,235.00. With the amount of cash in hand, we definitely have sufficient funds to purchase a digital sign to be placed on West Liberty Avenue. Last Monday, we met with the company representative to discuss design details which will include stone columns on either side of the sign as well as decorative metal work on the topside. Our church's name will be prominently displayed above the digital section, and it will easily be seen during evening hours.
